<b>1. Verbs followed by</b>		<b><u>to + base form</u></b>	
She	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>agreed</li> <li>arranged</li> <li>offered</li> <li>decided</li> <li>deserved</li> <li>expected</li> <li>hoped</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>intended</li> <li>managed</li> <li>could not afford</li> <li>pretended</li> <li>promised</li> <li>refused</li> <li>wanted</li> </ul>	<b>to play</b> the piano.

<b>2. Verbs followed by</b>		<b><u>the base-form</u></b>	
He	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>heard</li> <li>made</li> <li>watched</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>him</li> <li>her</li> <li>them</li> </ul>	<b>cry.</b>
You	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>had better</li> <li>had rather</li> <li>had sooner</li> </ul>	<b>leave</b> town.	

<b>3. Verbs followed by</b>		<b><u>the -ing form</u></b>	
He	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>admitted</li> <li>avoided</li> <li>couldn't help</li> <li>enjoyed</li> <li>fancied</li> <li>couldn't stand</li> <li>suggested</li> <li>was busy</li> </ul>	<b>eating</b> a lot.	

<b>4. Expressions followed by</b>		<b><u>the -ing form</u></b>	
She	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>was fond of</li> <li>accused me of</li> <li>was afraid of</li> <li>was good at</li> <li>thanked him for</li> <li>apologized for</li> <li>was interested in</li> <li>was used to</li> </ul>	<b>drinking</b> beer.
